
- For beginners If you are satisfied with the general look of your photos and just want to tweak them a little before sharing them, AliveColors allows you to resize, crop and apply filters with ease.

AliveColors photo editing software

1. Create new images easily

<u>AliveColors</u> provides a wide range of possibilities for creating images from scratch. The process to do that is also fairly simple, Open the "**New Image dialog windows by selecting File -> New** and make your selections as mentioned in the below screenshot.



2. Resize your photos without any hassles

You can resize an image using AliveColors image editor easily with several editing options like Scale layer effect, Constrain proportions and Image Resampling. To start, click **Image -> Image Size** and select options as per below screenshot.



3. Batch Processing for multiple files processing

Batch Processing allows you to automatically process multiple files consecutively without having to adjust settings for each image. Just create an action and apply it to a group of images.

To start, create New Action as shown below,



After that, Record Action that you can apply to all other images.

4. Edit color of your photos using Adjustments layers

Adjustment layers allow you to edit colors in photos without affecting its original pixels, meaning that your source image is maintained. It is a safe way of applying image adjustments.



To create a new adjustment layer, select Layers -> New -> Adjustment.



5. Other Adjustment Options

AliveColors offers a variety of adjustment options to choose. Some of the popular ones are mentioned below.

Level Adjustment

The Levels adjustment allows you to correct the tonal range and color balance of an image by adjusting image shadows, mid-tones, and highlights.

To start, select Layers -> New -> Adjustment Layers -> Layers.



Curves Adjustment

The Curves adjustment allows you to control the brightness and contrast of your image. The Curves adjustment is also used for tonal and color corrections.

To start, select Layers -> New -> Adjustment Layers -> Curves.

Invert Adjustment for negative image creation

The Invert adjustment inverts the image colors and brightness values to create a negative image.


To start, select Layers -> New -> Adjustment Layers -> Invert.



Threshold Adjustment

The Threshold adjustment turns an image into solid black and white by replacing all colors darker than a given threshold with black and all brighter colors with white.

To start, select Layers -> New -> Adjustment Layers -> Threshold.



Posterize Adjustment

The Posterize adjustment flattens the colors in the image by reducing the number of lightness levels in each color channel.

To start, select Layers -> New -> Adjustment Layers -> Posterize.

Black and White Adjustment

The Black & White adjustment allows converting a color image to grayscale as well as adjusting its overall color tone.

To start, select Layers -> New -> Adjustment Layers -> Black & White.

Brightness / Contrast Option

Using the Brightness/Contrast adjustment, you can correct image brightness and contrast and add color to dull photographs. Using this tab, you can make simple adjustments to the tonal range of your image.

To start, select Layers -> New -> Adjustment Layers -> Brightness / Contrast.

Hue / Saturation

The Hue/Saturation adjustment allows individual adjustment to each color channel or the entire image. Using this tab, you can change the color properties of your image.

Hue – modifies the overall hue or the hue of the selected color range.

Saturation – changes the saturation of the entire image or the selected color range.

To start, select Layers -> New -> Adjustment Layers -> Hue/Saturation.

6. Alignment tools in AliveColors image editor allow you to move and precisely position objects (layers).

Alignment settings can be adjusted using the Workspace menu in the Control Panel.


Settings Description

Rulers: This option enables the rulers along the edges of the Image Window

Grid: This option displays a regular grid of lines over the image

Guidelines: Check this option to view the guidelines


Snap: Snap option allows you to easily align objects to the grid, guidelines, selection, etc. You can make use of **Snap To**drop-down list to specify elements to which to snap.



7. Creating Texts

Using the **Text tool** in AliveColors, you can create multiline texts and style them by setting formatting options. The text automatically appears on a special text layer.

Among the many options, you can choose from a set of fonts while typing along with the size.




8. Built-in-plugins

AliveColors image editor offers a number of built-in AKVIS plugins that significantly extend its functionality. Following are some of them, which you can use.

- AirBrush (Effects -> Built-in Plugins -> AirBrush) transforms digital photos into airbrush drawings.
- Coloriage (Effects -> Built-in Plugins -> Coloriage) is a plug-in that lets you experiment with the colors in your photos: add color to black and white photos, replace colors on color photos, perform selective desaturation or coloring, etc.
- HDRFactory (Effects -> Built-in Plugins -> HDRFactory) helps you to quickly create High Dynamic Range images and perform photo corrections.

• LightShop (Effects -> Built-in Plugins -> LightShop) adds various light and star effects to the images. Below screenshot, shows the list of all available plugins till date.



Installing AliveColors

AliveColors is an easy to install photo editing software. To install, just follow the following simple steps.

Step 1

Download and Run the setup Alivecolors-setup.exe file (200 MB approx for version 1.2.1512.15969)

Step 2

Select the language and accept the license agreement.

Step 3

Choose the drive where you want to install the program, and select "Install."

Step 4

Press "Finish" to exit Setup. You can now start the program from Start menu or through the shortcut o the desktop.
